WHEREAS, the West Valley City MyHometown Interfaith Council is committed to creating a more respectful and inclusive City by offering a place for all faith leaders to come together in harmony, recognizing common values and building cooperativity and interreligious dialogue;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Mayor and City Council of West Valley City do hereby proclaim February 1-7, 2024 as World Interfaith Week in West Valley City and invites the residents of West Valley City to join in observing World Interfaith Harmony Week.
